What is Summer SuRF?

Summer SuRF is a joint effort of St. Francis of Assisi and St. Louis parish youth ministries. Youth currently in grades 6-8 in the 2018-19 school year are invited to a week of **Service, Reflection & Fun!** It's a great chance for middle schoolers to put their faith into action. Throughout the week, we'll be serving people who are elderly, hungry, and living in poverty. We'll spend time in prayer and reflection as well as building community within and beyond our parishes.

What does the day look like?

Each day (except Wednesday), we'll meet at St. Francis of Assisi (8300 Old Columbia Rd, Fulton, MD 20759) and divide into teams. The teams will serve at a different service site each day then re-gather with the large group to reflect on the day and build community with fun activities!

Who is leading the week?

Coordinators: The week is being coordinated by Becki Kaman, Director of Youth & Young Adult Ministries at St. Francis of Assisi and supported by Pat Sprankle, Director of Youth Ministry at St. Louis.

Planning Team & Chaperones: Adult volunteers are needed to join the Planning Team, as well as to chaperone and drive throughout the week. Chaperones can commit to one or more days of *Summer SuRF*. As a thank you, chaperones may take a \$10/family discount for each day that they volunteer on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. Planning Team members should be able to chaperone for at least part of the week. Hersheypark chaperones will be signed up separately.
